

# LEADING THE COMMUNITY BY EXAMPLE


Leadership -- One of the most important values to Pi Kappa Alpha was exceptionally shown by Theta Kappa throughout the community this fall semester. Over 700 community service hours were logged and approved by the university, as each member had multiple opportunities to showcase their commitment to the well being of the community. Some of the various projects included: IUS Move-In Day, Habitat for Humanity, The Walk to End Alzheimers, Crusade for Children and serving in leadership roles on campus such as orientation leaders and Inter Fraternity Council President.

Theta Kappa proactively led the university by offering open, educational programs. "A Shot of Reality" offered alcohol safety training to over 100 students. In order to raise awareness for the battle against self-harm, the chapter hosted QPR Training which certified brothers and members of the university in suicide prevention.

For the second year in a row, Theta Kappa Chapter won the Grenadier Cup at IU Southeast. PIKE is still the only fraternity on campus to take home this honor, and the only student organization to win the cup more than once. The chapter was judged in four competitions: Door decoration, banner decoration, a corn-hole tournament and a tailgate competition before the men's and women's basketball games on Homecoming Day.
